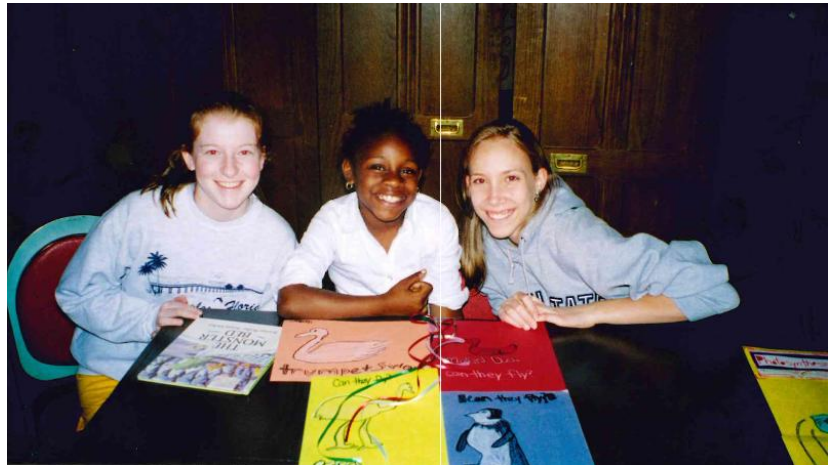
Eport Center Board of Directors Welcomes Its Newest Member
